
## **Placebo Batch Numbers**

The Danish study [Danish Study] found that one third of the batches were placebos. What's more the German regulators only tested the medium and high toxicity batches [See this article - German Testing] - they never tested the placebos - presumably because they knew they were just saline.

## The Batch Numbers

When we look at the placebo batch numbers that make up the Danish placebo group we find an interesting phenomenon. Look at the table where the high toxicity lots are in blue, the medium toxicity lots are in green and the placebo lots are in yellow.



## Notice that -

- The high toxicity batches have lot numbers in the alpha numeric range EJ EK EL EM
- The medium toxicity lots have lot numbers EP ER ET EW EX EY FA FC FD FE FF and FG
- The placebos (ultra low toxicity) have lot numbers FG FH FJ FK FL FM

You probably notice that the three different toxicity levels are all alphanumeric series in ascending order.

## **Tested or Un-Tested**

"ja" means tested; "Nein" means not tested.

Note that all the blue lots were tested. All the green lots were tested EXCEPT three which happen to be FD, FF, and FG - (all at the highest alphanumeric end for that green group). And note that in the yellow group none were tested EXCEPT one, FG, which happens to be at the lowest alphanumeric position for this yellow group).
